HISTORY



Name: West Ham United Women

West Ham United Women have been an integral part of the club's legacy since the 1970s, when the "ladies section" was first introduced. By 1991, the women's team officially became part of West Ham United, marking the start of a new era for women's football at the club. In 1995, the team celebrated back-to-back promotions, solidifying its presence in English football.

The 1998–99 season saw the Hammers reach their first cup final in the Russell Cup and finish as runners-up in the league. This success set the foundation for the team's future, which culminated in their entry into the FA Women's Super League (WSL) in 2018. In their debut WSL season, they achieved an impressive 6th-place finish.

In 2019, another landmark moment came when West Ham United Women played their first match at the iconic London Stadium against Tottenham Hotspur. A record 24,790 supporters attended, making it the second-largest crowd in WSL history at the time.

The 2025-26 season will be the club's 35th season in existence and our seventh in the Barclays Women's Super League, the highest level of England's football pyramid. Alongside competing in the WSL, the club will also contest two domestic cup competitions: the Adobe Women's FA Cup and the Subway Women's League Cup. On 20 July 2023 Rehanne Skinner was appointed manager of West Ham United F.C. Women, becoming our first female manager in the WSL era.

We're excited for what lies ahead and look forward to your support on matchdays.

Traveling from the North & West

If you are coming from the North or West, follow the M25 Clockwise until junction 27 and take the M11 towards London. Proceed along the M11 and as the road splits at the end of the motorway follow the signs for A406 South θ A13. There are speed cameras along this road and the speed limit is 50 mph. After 5 miles, take the slip road on the left signposted A13 Dagenham, Tilbury and Southend. There are speed cameras along this road and the speed limit is 40 mph.

Go under the underpass and over the flyover and with the leisure complex on your left bear left onto the A1306 signposted Dagenham East. At the fifth set of lights with McDonalds in front of you, tern left onto the A1112, Ballards Road. The speed limit is 30mph and there is a speed camera on your left. At the Bull Roundabout bear left and go past Dagenham East Tube Station. Victoria Road is the fifth turning on the left.

From the South & East Via Dartford Crossing

Follow signs for A13 to Dagenham/ Central London. Proceed along this road and take the turn off signposted Elm Park & Dagenham East and turn right at the roundabout at the bottom of the slip road. Proceed to the set of lights and turn left onto a dual carriageway.

After about half a mile you will see a McDonalds on your right. Get into the right-hand filter lane and turn right onto the A1112 Ballards Road. The speed limit is 30 mph and there is a speed camera on your left. At the Bull roundabout bear left and go past Dagenham East Tube Station. Victoria Road is the fifth turning on the left.

Parking

Unfortunately, there is no parking available at Victoria Road. There is a small amount of street parking available on the main road on Sundays which is subject to availability. There are no facilities for coach or shuttle bus parking except for the away team coach.

Accesible Parking

We have very limited accessible parking available at Victoria Road. If you have purchased a ticket and wish to request Blue Badge parking, please contact <u>accessibility@westhamunited.co.uk</u> ahead of the fixture with your client reference number.

London Underground


The nearest station is Dagenham East, which is on the District Line of London's Underground Network. After exiting the station, turn left and the ground is the fifth turning on the left (about 400 meters from the station).

Rail

Board the Greater Anglia service from London Liverpool Street to Romford Station. When exiting Romford station, cross the road and turn right to catch the 103 bus from Romford Station Stop Y (heading towards Rainham Station). Get off the bus at the Victoria Road Dagenham stop, which is right outside the ground.

CATERING



Victoria Road has a club house which welcomes all home and visiting supporters, including families. Entry for non-members is charged at 50p per person. Once in the bar area you will find an extensive range of beverages and TVs showing Sky and TNT Sports.

There are a number of catering kiosks located in each stand serving the following:

- Soft drinks
- Hot drinks

Catering facilities are located within each stand near the turnstiles. If you have any questions please speak with the stewards, Supporter Liaison Officers or catering staff.







Accessible Parking

We have very limited accessible parking available at Victoria Road. If you wish to request Blue Badge parking, please contact accessibility@westhamunited.co.uk ahead of the fixture with your client reference number.

You are unable to request parking if you have not purchased a ticket and all queries should be directed to accessibility@westhamunited.co.uk

Accessible seating

There is accessible seating located in the Jax Sun West, Jax Sun East, Family Stand and SD Samuel Stand where there are ramps on either of the stand to gain access to the accessible seating. If you have any queries on the day, please speak to a member of the SLO or stewarding team.

Disabled Supporters' Assistants

On matchdays, our dedicated Disabled Supporters' Assistants are here to support all fans with accessible needs. Easily identifiable in their pink tabards, they are stationed at the entrances and all turnstiles to provide assistance, answer any questions, and ensure that every supporter has a comfortable and enjoyable experience at the stadium. Disabled Supporters' Association and contact information

The West Ham United Disabled Supporters Association (WHUDSA) grew from the success of West Ham United's Disabled Supporters Board. Set up in 2017, the standalone Board has fan representatives from a cross-section of disabilities and range of ages.

The Disabled Supporters' Association have regular meetings with the Club, the Accessibility Team and pertinent staff and strive to further improve the matchday experience for disabled supporters at London Stadium, for those attending away matches and Victoria Road.

Your ticket


All match tickets will be sent approximately 7 days prior to the fixture.

MATCHDAY SUPPORTER LIAISON OFFICERS



As part of our ongoing commitment to providing fans with a positive matchday experience, a dedicated team of Supporter Liaison Officers (SLOs) are stationed at key points around Victoria Road to help and assist you with any queries or concerns you may have.

Our matchday SLOs will be located at the car park entrance, at the turnstiles, at the bottom of each stand and at matchday programme stands. They will be wearing a blue tabard with Matchday SLO on the back. Head to the Supporter Services tent if you have any questions.

As well as greeting and helping fans find their way around the stadium, the SLO team will be handing out First Time Certificates to those attending their first match at Victoria Road, Junior Hammer wristbands and an exclusive range of collectibles. You can also buy your programme from the Supporter Services tent.


PROGRAMME

SAFETY, SECURITY AND POLICIES



Reporting concerns

West Ham United has a zero-tolerance approach to any form of discrimination. Equality, equity, diversity and inclusion are at the heart of the Club and we are committed to ensuring that everyone feels welcome to attend our fixtures in a safe environment.

Any form of discriminatory behaviour or chanting is unacceptable; it has no place in football and has serious criminal consequences. West Ham United will take the strongest possible action against any individual found to be engaging in such behaviour, including potential lifetime bans and referral to the police.

The Club can also face disciplinary action if any of its supporters are found to have engaged in this behaviour, which is not representative of the West Ham United fanbase and will not be tolerated by the Club.

West Ham United provides a number of support mechanisms on matchday to ensure that supporters can report any incidents discreetly and in confidence. To report any incidents during a match, you can speak with the nearest steward or Supporter Liaison Officer, or text our new reporting line on 07701401966. You can also contact West Ham United at supporterservices@westhamunited. co.uk. Please provide as much information as possible, including the stand, row, seat number, description of the offender and incident.

We believe that the overwhelming majority of West Ham United supporters share these values and will work with us to continue to protect the Club's status as an equity leader in the Premier League, a position recognised and acknowledged through our award and continuous retention of the Advanced level Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Standard – the League's highest accolade attainable in this area. Anyone attending matches who does not share these values, does not share the diverse and inclusive values that West Ham United and our community stand for.

Flag Policy

Flags will be permitted into Victoria Road if they have been manufactured to British Standards and has been certified as fire retardant (the certificate will need to be produced). The content of the flag must not be derogatory, nor should it contain any language or wording deemed to be potentially inflammatory or inappropriate to any individual or group. Any defamatory, political or inappropriate flags will not be permitted.

RECOMMENDED ITEMS



It can get cold during the winter months at Victoria Road, so it's essential to stay warm to enjoy the match in comfort. We recommend bringing the following items:

Warm Jacket/Coat – A waterproof or insulated coat to protect against cold and rain.

Hat – A wool or fleece beanie to keep your head warm.

Gloves – Insulated gloves to protect your hands from the cold.

Scarf – A warm scarf (West Ham colors if you have one!) to cover your neck.

Layers – Wear multiple layers, like a thermal shirt, sweatshirt, and fleece to add extra warmth.

Thermal Socks – Thick or thermal socks to keep your feet warm in your boots or shoes.

Portable Hand Warmers – Small, single-use or rechargeable hand warmers to keep in your pockets.

Blanket – A small, foldable blanket if you're sitting outside for an extended period.

These essentials should help you stay comfortable and enjoy the match no matter the weather!
